Warning about giving honey to pup · age: Honey can contain spores of clostridium botulism bacteria which makes puppies (and children) susceptible - around until 12 months of age. These bacteria are typically harmless to older dogs (and children/adults) because their mature digestive systems can move the spores through the y body before they cause any harm. But the very young haven't developed the ability to handle the spores yet. So once a puppy ingests the spores the bacteria germinate, multiply, and produce a toxin. That toxin interferes with the normal interaction between the muscles and nerves and can hamper a puppy's ability to move, eat, and breathe. Signs and` Symptoms- oms Symptoms of botulism appear between 3 to 30 days after a puppy consumes the spores. Constipation is `often the first sign of botulism, seek veterinarian assistance if you puppy is showing signs of botulism.
